Advanced Driver Training Course

The Central Massachusetts Safety Council is the longest running auto school of its type in the area. We have been teaching skid control for **over 25 years** and unlike other facilities, CMSC offers Advanced Driver Training (ADT) **weekly, all year long**. Our classes are held in all weather conditions including sunshine, rain, sleet, and snow.

The ADT program runs **four hours** in duration (depending on class size) and combines a **two hour classroom** session with **hands-on, in-car, vehicle control training**. This training has proven to be extremely popular with schools, businesses, and various organizations who wish to **reduce liability** and/or to **improve driving and safety records** of their employees. Parents have also found this training to be invaluable for the same reasons.



Advanced Driver Training classes are held **several times a month**. Students may enroll in a **one-on-one** class or may enroll in a **group compatible** class (recommended). **Students are required to possess a valid driver's license.**



Because we **tailor our training classes to the client's specific needs**, we utilize several types of vehicles. This enables our students to learn basic vehicle control. They will also learn to control vehicles with similar characteristics to those used on the job. Basic instruction is given in a **front-wheel drive** passenger sedan with an **automatic transmission**. However, for more specialized training we use more specific vehicles. The Safety Council has a variety of automobiles including a **Crown Victoria police cruiser**, a **dual rear-wheel "cube" ambulance truck**, a **Dodge window van**, and a **32-foot Waste Management truck**.

TRACK/SKID PAD

The track portion of the training places students behind the wheel in a dedicated "skid pad" environment. Students are taught the principles of handling and car control, off-road recovery, emergency accident & obstacle avoidance, and skid control. An in-car instructor carefully monitors student progress and safety at all times.
