



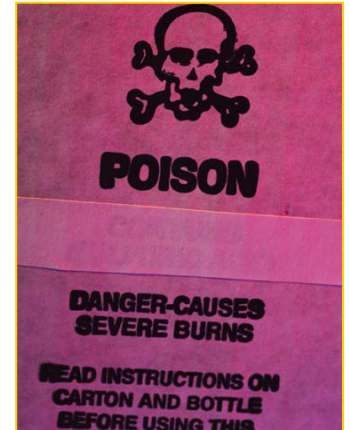
Central Mass Safety Council Right to Know (Hazard Communication) OSHA required training
